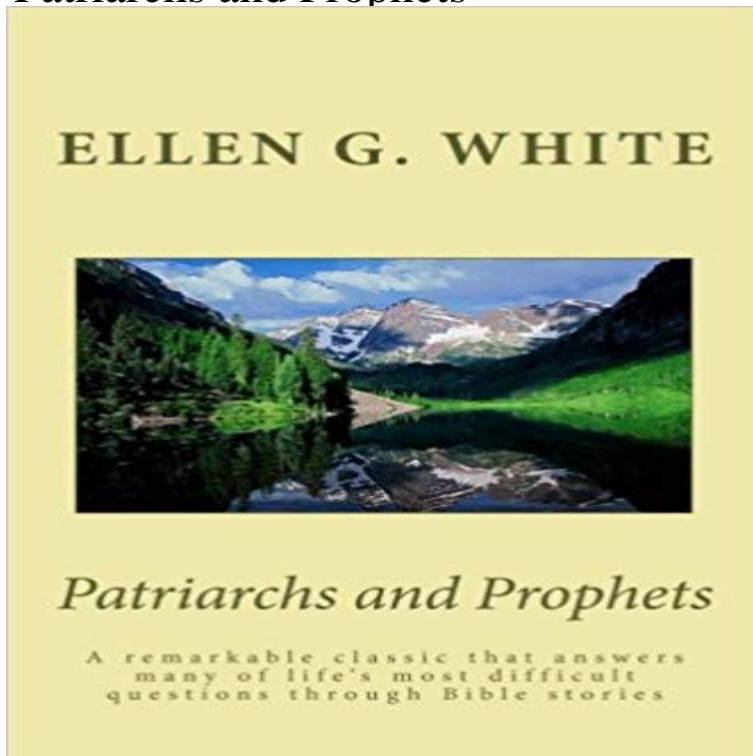


Patriarchs and Prophets
