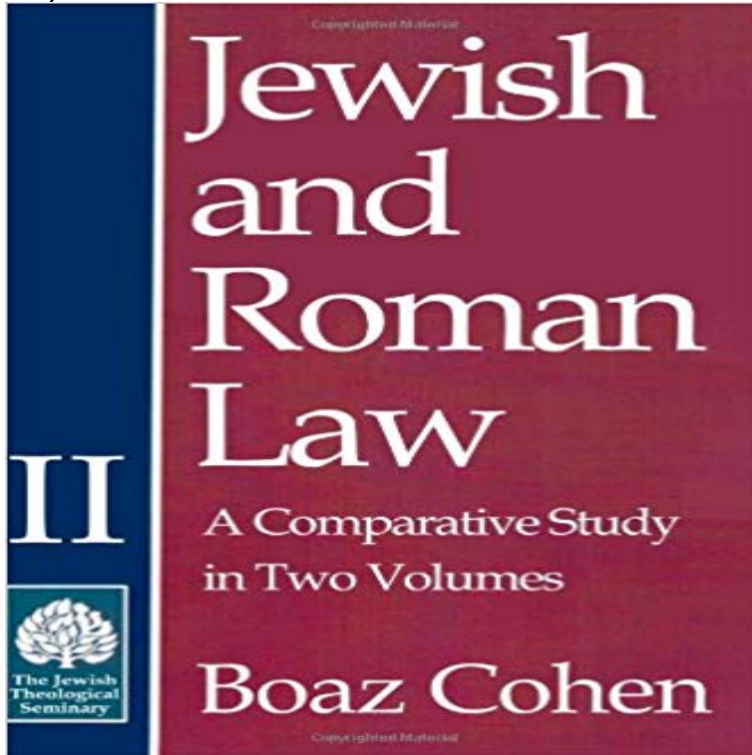


Jewish and Roman Law: Comparative Study in Two Volumes (Volume II)
