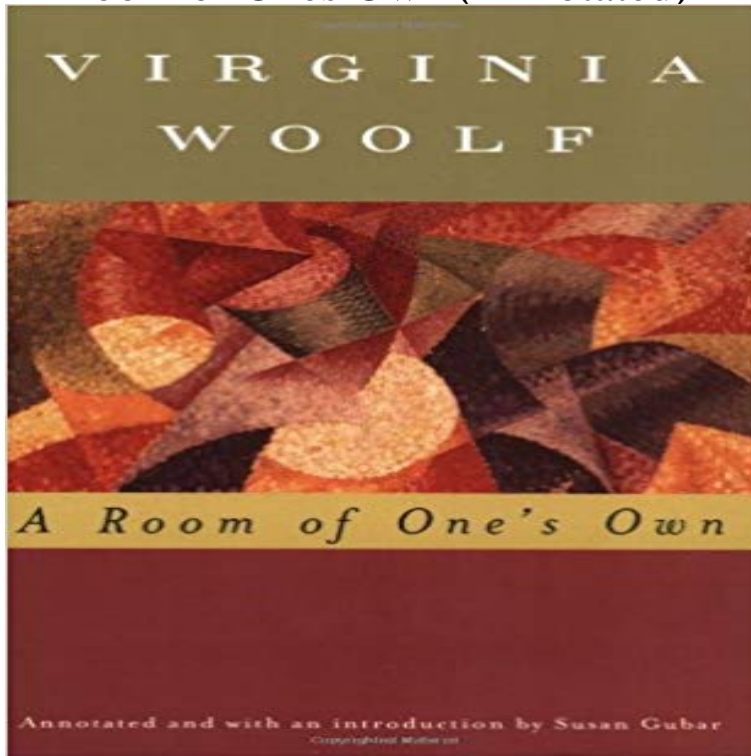


A Room of Ones Own (Annotated)
