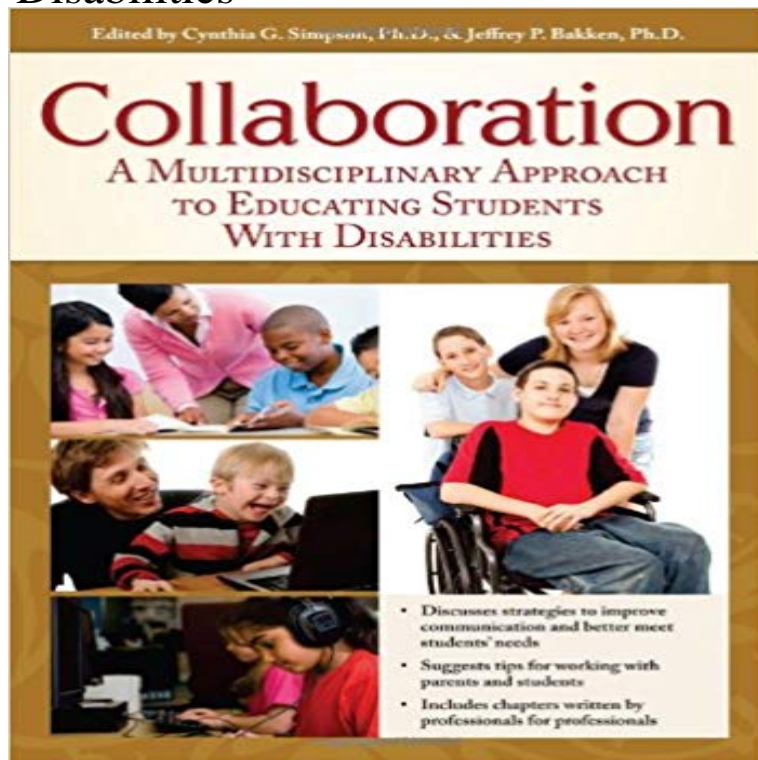


Collaboration: A Multidisciplinary Approach to Educating Students With Disabilities
