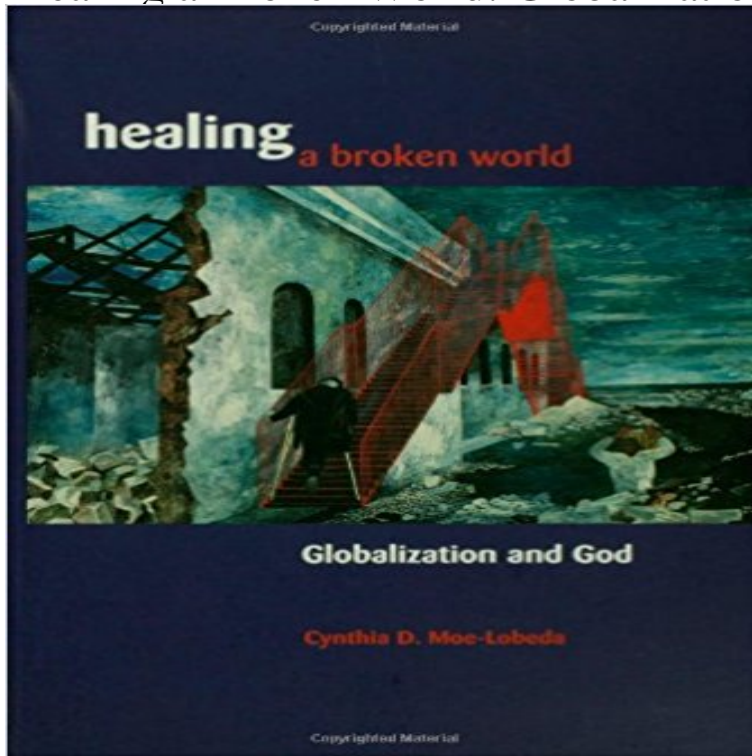


Healing a Broken World: Globalization and God
