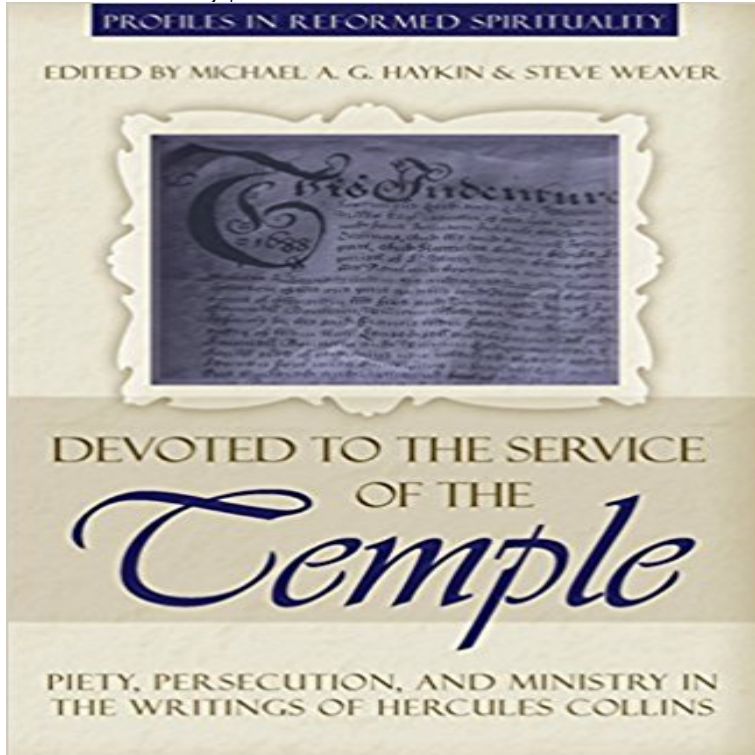


Devoted to the Service of the Temple: Piety, Persecution, and Ministry in the Writings of Hercules Collins



While largely forgotten in modern times, Hercules Collins (1646/1702) was highly influential among the late 17th and early 18th century Calvinistic Baptists of London. Through a biographical sketch and 35 sample selections collected from Collins writings, Michael A.G. Haykin and Steve Weaver introduce us to the vibrant spirituality of this colossal figure.
