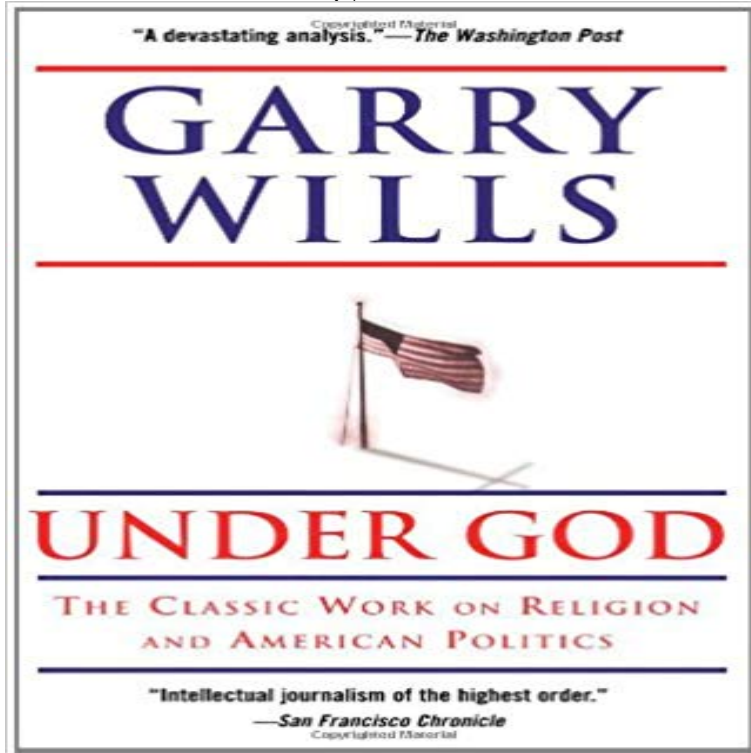


Under God: Religion and American Politics
