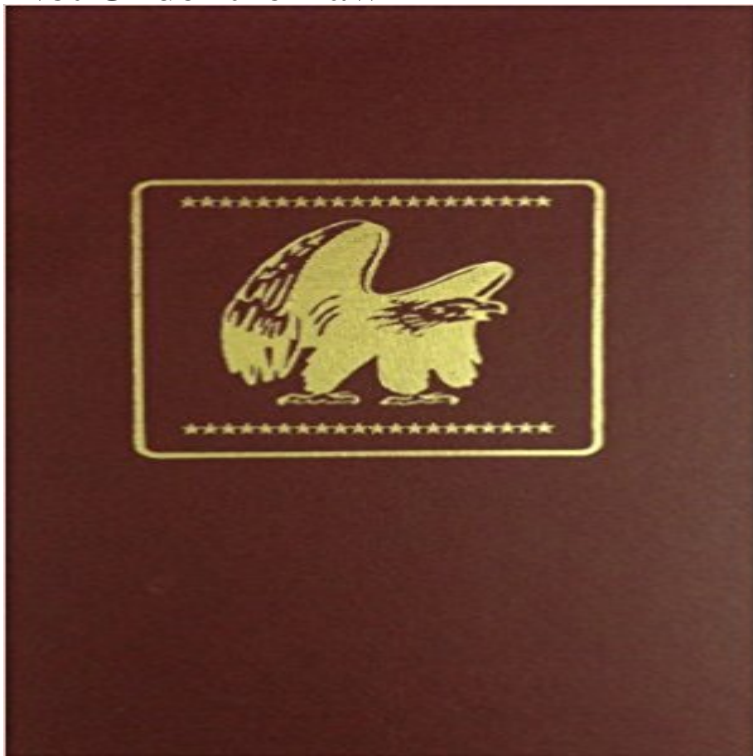


Not Under the Law
