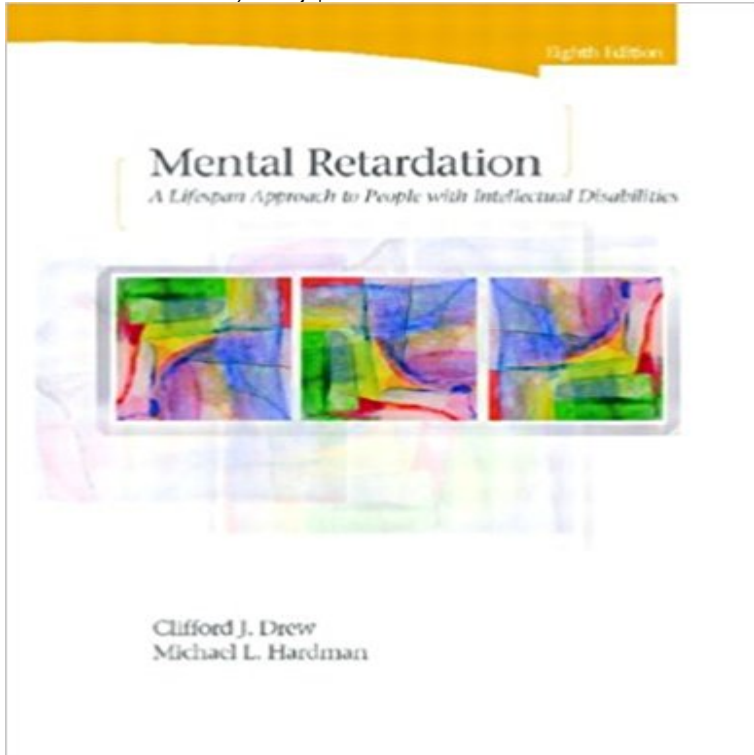


# Mental Retardation: A LifeSpan Approach to People with Intellectual Disabilities, Eighth Edition
