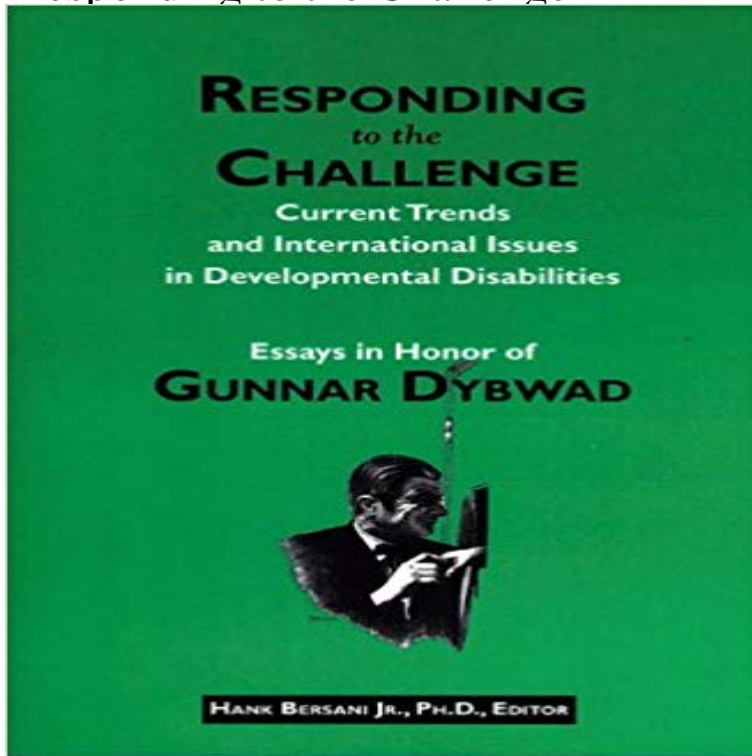


Responding to the Challenge
